ELIGIBILITY

- The nominee must have earned a BS, MS or PhD from the College of Engineering, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.
- An alumnus can receive this award only once.

NOMINATION

- Anyone, especially alumni, staff and friends of the College of Engineering, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, may nominate a candidate.
- The nomination package shall be submitted to the Distinguished Alumni Selection Committee.
- While preference will be given to nominees living at the time of selection, posthumous awards may be made to the immediate family.

SELECTION

- The dean of the College of Engineering will establish the Distinguished Alumni Selection Committee that will rank the nominations received. Committee members may be selected from the faculty, Engineering Alumni Association and the Development Advisory Committee.
- The dean will make the final decision based on the recommendation from the Selection Committee.

Up to three additional pages may be submitted with supporting information such as letters of support, copies of awards, other items to show your nominee's accomplishments. In addition, the nominee's curriculum vitae (please limit this to 5 pages) should be included.
