Facilities Development Branch seeks the assistance of college architect and engineering interns to help us manage multiple jobs that deal with various disciplines of work, including architecture, civil, geotechnical, surveying, archaeology, historic preservation, landscape, structural, electrical, mechanical, fire protection, telecom, environmental hazmat, and sustainability.

The interns will observe the design and construction industry from the viewpoint of the owner. Under the guidance of a Planner or Project Manager, the interns will become familiar with the variety of jobs that take place in support of public school facilities statewide and learn the steps a job goes through. Tasks may include, but not be limited to, the following:

- School campus research
- Assisting with developing a comprehensive scope of work based on the needs of the users and site context
- Compiling contract documents
- Participating in review of design documents
- Tracking of permitting agency reviews
- Assisting with construction bid reviews
- Tracking and filing of job related documents
