## Obligation of an Engineer

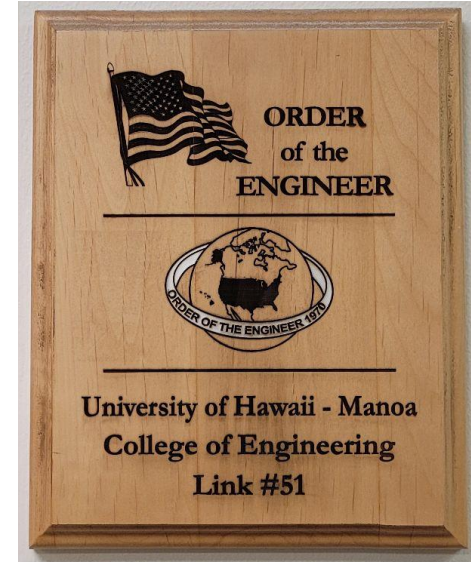
Similar to the *Hippocratic oath* and taken with your classmates to uphold the standards and dignity of the engineering profession

Stainless steel ring, worn on the fifth finger of the working hand to remind you of your obligation to uphold the standards and dignity of the engineering profession


Ring is free but participation in Convocation required to receive the ring



# Mid Semester **ACTIONS** required

- 2) **Pay your \$30 Manoa Diploma Fee** which should be showing in your account balance in MyUH or STAR once you are showing as “Petitioned”.

## 2 Weeks after Finals

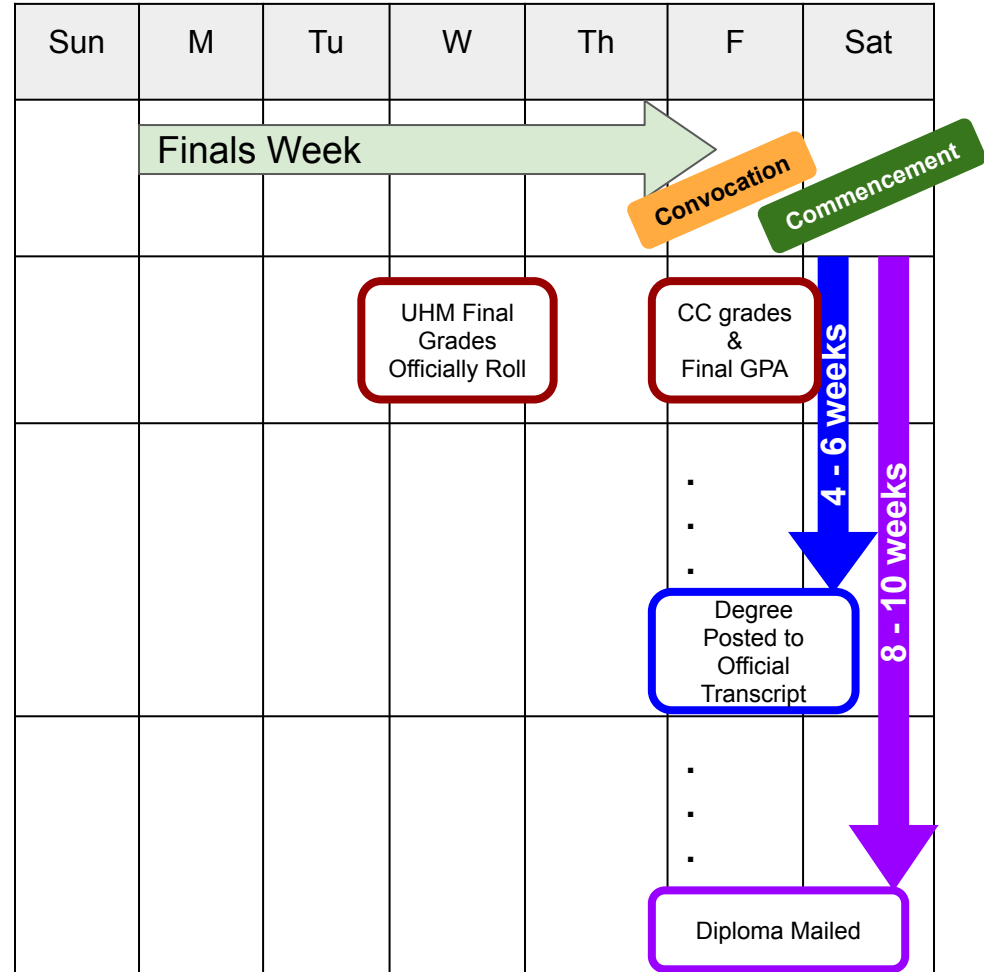
CoE will complete the final graduation checks after final grades officially roll to confirm all of our graduates to the UHM Office of the Registrar.

## ~ 4 - 6 Weeks after Graduation

UHM Office of the Registrar will post the awarded degrees to the confirmed students' records. Final Official Transcripts can be ordered.

## ~ 8 - 10 Weeks after Graduation

Printing company mails diplomas directly to the mailing address indicated on students' Degree Application.



# How and when do I know that I graduated?

Be sure to check that you passed all of your courses with the *appropriate grades and minimum 2.0 overall and major GPAs* needed to graduate.

Check at the end of the week after finals.

If you passed all of your courses and have both overall and major GPAs of 2.0 or higher then you will be graduating.

You will receive an email from the CoE stating that your degree will be awarded usually 2 weeks after finals. **Congratulations!**

If you did not pass all of your courses or do not have both overall and major GPAs of 2.0 or higher then you will not be graduating.

1) Contact the Director of Academic Affairs at [enqr@eng.hawaii.edu](mailto:enqr@eng.hawaii.edu), to discuss last requirements and re-filing to graduate.

2) Contact the Office of the Registrar at [uhmdipls@hawaii.edu](mailto:uhmdipls@hawaii.edu) to ask them to reopen your registration for the upcoming semester.

**\*\* If you do not do the above two steps, you will be unable to register to retake courses for graduation. \*\***



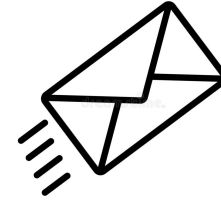

Diplomas are not typically not used as your proof of degree. Many Employers or Graduate Schools will ask for your final official transcript as proof of degree.



# Letter of Confirmation

My employer or graduate school is requesting proof of degree **before** my final official transcript is ready.

CoE can write a letter confirming that you have met all requirements to graduate w/ final gpas. The earliest these letters can be generated is 2 weeks after finals.

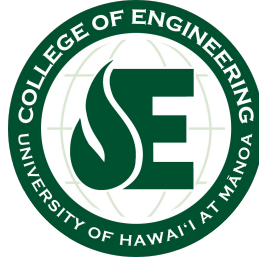
Contact Director of Academic Affairs at [enr@eng.hawaii.edu](mailto:enr@eng.hawaii.edu) to request letter and include:

- Email or Mailing address of recipients
- Company or School affiliation of the recipients



If your employer does not need proof of degree until after transcripts are ready (~4-6 weeks after graduation), then you should order your final official transcripts and you **do not need to request a letter.**
