2025 Scholarship Awards:

- One (1) Scholarship at \$3,000 (3.0 GPA requirement) for junior/community college students.
- One (1) Scholarship at \$3,000 (3.0 GPA requirement) for college/university students.
- One (1) Scholarship at \$3,000 (3.0 GPA requirement) for high school students enrolling in these programs.
- Each recipient will receive two (2) tickets to attend the End of Year Paina awards ceremony where the scholarships are to be awarded. The event Date and time will be announced at a later date.

2025 Scholarship Requirements (Out of High School):

- You must be an Undergraduate or Graduate student currently enrolled in a degree program (ANY YEAR). Parttime students are acceptable when enrolled in a degree program.
- You must be pursuing a degree in Construction Management, Architecture, or Engineering.
- You must currently have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- You must be able to provide official transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate work if requested.
- You cannot apply if you are a previous recipient of the CMAA Hawaii Chapter Scholarship.
- Your college or university must be located in the State of Hawaii.

2025 Scholarship Requirements (High School):

- You must be a High School Senior currently enrolled or planning to enroll in a degree program (with proof of application or counselor recommendation). Part-time students are acceptable when enrolled in a degree program.
- You must be pursuing a degree in Construction Management, Architecture, or Engineering.
- You must currently have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- You must be able to provide official transcripts of all High School work if requested.
- You cannot apply if you are a previous recipient of the CMAA Hawaii Chapter Scholarship.
- Your college or university must be located in the State of Hawaii.

2025 Scholarship Recipient Requirements:

• Scholarship recipient must prepare and submit a brief video (1 minute or less) describing themselves, his/her favorite activities and why he/she desires a career in construction management. This may be shown at the Scholarship/Awards Banquet and other Social Media outlets including the CMAA Hawaii Website.

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Application Process:

- The application is provided in Microsoft Word format, and applicants are required to complete it electronically using a computer. Attachments are to be submitted in PDF format and attached at the end of this document (see pages at the end for sequence).
- Essays MUST follow the format instructions provided in the essay section of the application.
- Keep a copy of your complete application package.
- No hand deliveries of applications are accepted.

- A confirmation email will be sent to you when applications are received.

Evaluation Process:

- Applications are evaluated by the CMAA Hawaii Chapter Executive Board. The decisions of the CMAA Hawaii Chapter Board are final.
- CMAA Hawaii Executive Board will evaluate the applications based on:
 - (a) academic excellence
 - (b) video content
 - (c) essay content
- CMAA Hawaii Executive Board will give preference to applicants who are members of a CMAA Student Chapter.
- The CMAA Hawaii Chapter will notify scholarship winners at least three (3) weeks prior to the Scholarship/Awards Banquet. Recipients will be introduced and will receive their scholarship checks at the Scholarship/Awards Banquet.
